

## Public Notice

The City of Crystal River residents are invited to apply for our City Volunteer Boards. The Planning Commission and Waterfronts Advisory Board currently have vacancies.

**Planning Commission.** These terms are for 3 years. The Planning Commission serves as the Local Planning Agency (LPA) pursuant to Florida Statutes and makes recommendations to the City Council regarding various issues and applications that come before this Commission relative to zoning, subdivisions, planned unit developments, variances and other types of land use scenarios.

**Waterfronts Florida Advisory Board.** The terms for these positions are 4 years. This Board is charged with studying and monitoring water quality of Kings Bay, the Floridian aquifer, flora and fauna, the care and protection of the Florida Manatee and the impact of storm water and septic tanks.

**Tree City USA Board.** This is a 3-year term. This Board is charged to study, investigate, counsel and develop and/or update annually, and administer a written plan for the care, preservation, pruning, planting, replanting, removal or disposition of trees and shrubs in parks, along streets and in other public areas.
