\$7.50 parking all day for a vehicle with a trailer (if applicable) 8-foot maximum length.

\$5.00 Paddle-craft launch fee (per vessel)

NW 3rd Avenue Boat Ramp: Parking/Launch Fees

\$5.00 parking all day (located at Fire Department across U.S. 19)

\$7.50 fee for trailer parking all day (located at Fire Department across U.S. 19).

\$5.00 Launch fee (per vessel)

Pete's Pier Boat Ramp: Launch Fee

\$5.00 Launch fee (per vessel)

Parking fee is paid directly to Pete's Pier attendant (not included in Annual Passes)

Non-commercial Resident Annual Parking/Motorized Vessel Pass:

\$50.00 per year, per vehicle, includes unlimited parking at Hunter Springs Park, King's Bay Park, and the Fire Department lot on U.S. 19. (Excludes Pete's Pier parking). Pass includes resident motorized vessel launches at the two city owned boat ramps.

Non-commercial Citrus County Resident Annual Motorized Vessel Launch Pass:

\$75.00 per year, per vehicle or trailer, includes unlimited parking at Fire Department lot on U.S. 19 and unlimited boat launch at NW 3rd Avenue boat ramp and Pete's Pier. Pass does not include paddle-craft launch fees or parking at Pete's Pier or any other city-owned metered parking sites.

Commercial Business Annual Boat Pass:

\$100.00 per year, per vehicle or trailer, includes unlimited parking at Fire Department lot on U.S. 19 and unlimited motorized vessel launch at NW 3rd Avenue Boat Ramp and the Boat Ramp at Pete's Pier. Commercial Annual Pass does not include parking at Pete's Pier or any other city-owned metered parking sites.

Resident of City of Crystal River Annual Paddle-Craft Launch Pass:

\$5.00 per paddle-craft or \$20.00 per residential address (with valid ID) for up to 10 resident-owned paddle-craft, includes unlimited launches at Hunter Springs Park and King's Bay Park.
