The Community Redevelopment Area consists of approximately 605.7 acres. This is about 23.5% of the area of Crystal River. See Community Redevelopment Map, page 8. The boundaries of the Redevelopment Area are:

- West: Beginning in the William's Point subdivision at N.W. 7th Avenue with lot 0100-A-50 go in an northerly direction to N.W. 6th Street. Then west to N.W. 8th Avenue go in a northerly direction across U.S. Highway 19 to N.W. 7th Terrace. East on N.W. 7th Terrace to N.W. 6th Avenue. North on N.W. 6th Avenue to Crystal Street.
- **North**: Boundaries include all the area south of Crystal Street between N.W. 6th Avenue and N.E.3rd Avenue and includes those subdivision lots north of Crystal Street to include Resub. Blk. C Subdivision:

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• East: Beginning at Crystal Street and N.E. 3rd Avenue, proceed in a southerly direction to U.S. Highway 19. Follow U.S. 19 toward the south to S.E. 1st Terrace.

• **South**: Beginning at the intersection of U.S. 19 and S.E. 1st Terrace, continue east to Cutler Spur Boulevard (Three Sisters Springs Trail) to Springdale Subdivision, lot 0120-000-22, and along its southern boundary to Hunter's Spring. The Redevelopment Area includes all properties north of a line passing through Hunter's Spring and King's Bay, returning to the point of beginning of the western boundary.
